## **Atlas of Butterflies in Highland and Moray**

This is now at the printers and will be launched at the Scottish Members' Day at Battleby.

The atlas documents the distribution of 30 species of butterflies in the period 1980 - 2007 in the area covered by Highland Branch. It is based on some 40,000 records contributed by over 750 recorders. It presents a snapshot of our current knowledge and a baseline for studying changes and trends in the future.

Individual species accounts give notes on general status and distribution together with population trends, habitat, flight period, larval foodplants, appearance and behaviour. A chapter describes and maps the range-expansion of four species during the recent period.

A collection of photographs shows the attractiveness of many of our resident butterflies as well as giving an indication of the differences between some of the species that can be tricky to tell apart at first sight.

It will be particularly pleasing to do the launch on SNH premises since they provided substantial funding to enable its production to go ahead. It will, of course be available at the AGM and the price is £4, but at a discount price of £3 to Branch members.
